1. **BAND BUSES MUST follow the designated Parade Shuttle from band drop-off area in Parade Staging to End-Of-Parade Staging at MacGregor School.**
2. **NO OBJECTS OF ANY KIND MAY BE DISTRIBUTED OR THROWN TO THE PARADE SPECTATORS FROM ANY PARADE UNIT. THIS IS A SAFETY HAZARD, AND VIOLATORS WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE PARADE ROUTE.**
3. **A short (*60-second*) drill may be performed periodically throughout the parade as long as fifty (50) feet spacing is maintained between entries. Bands can be either Forward Motion or stop 50 feet before the Judge's Review Stand on Cedar Blvd. and will be given a 30-second set-up time. This will be strictly enforced.**
4. Parade officials will be stationed along the parade route. They will be clearly identified (orange vests) and their authority must be respected.
5. Competition scoring will be conducted by professional judges from the Pacific Coast Judges Association. The decision of the judges is final in all cases. This parade is sanctioned by the Parade Sponsors Association of Northern California and winners earn points toward the Association's year-end awards.
6. All entries must complete the parade route. Disbanding of your unit shall not occur prior to the Lake Blvd. light at MacGregor School. Units disbanding early shall be disqualified from competition.
7. Parade entries shall have visual identification (e.g. street banner, vehicle banners, etc.). Signage must conform to the specifications of the parade organizing committee. Any questions pertaining to banners/signs should be directed to the parade chair.
8. The Judges and Announcer stands will be located on the right side of the line of march.
9. Security arrangements for entries are the responsibility of the participants. Neither the Newark Days Parade Committee nor its agents are responsible or liable for your entry.
10. Band Boosters are asked to walk on the off-camera (left-side) of their entry; however, they should remain out of the judging area.
11. The Newark Days Celebration, Inc. and the Parade Committee are not responsible for false statements made by the entrant.
12. Note that the winner of the Band Sweepstakes Award, which includes a Trophy and \$500, will be removed from eligibility for a Class Placement/Award. **The Sweepstakes Band is the Best Overall Band** and, therefore, eligible for the Higher monetary award.
13. **Award checks will be given out at the same day at the Awards Ceremony scheduled for 2:00 p.m. at the Main Stage located behind the Community Center.**
