Happy Friday! We have officially made it to Spring Break 2021 and I couldn't be more proud of the effort that NSH students and staff have put in thus far this year. Before we head out to break here are some updates that you should be aware of:

- Spring break will be March 29-April 2. School will resume Monday April 5, 2021 at normally scheduled time.
- Progress reports will be generated and mailed home shortly after we return back to school. This will provide you a snapshot of your students current grades, however should you wish to view your students grades earlier Infinite Campus will be accessible during the spring break time frame.
- Please see attached a scholarship opportunity for female students. Follow the instructions on the sheet provided to apply.
- We will be giving the SAT and PSAT when we return back from break. Please see the attached sheet detailing the days of those standardized tests. At this point, all 11th grade students should plan to come in person to take those assessments, as well as grade 9 and 10 students taking the PSAT. We will be doing pre-administration for the SAT the week of April 5. More information regarding the time of the pre-administration and logistics will be sent during Spring Break.
- PSAT scores from Fall 2020 have arrived! Students in grades 9 and 10 will receive their scores in Advisory on Friday March 26 to be brought home to their parents/guardians. Please be on the lookout for these.
- Students received PSAT packets Thursday March 25 from Mrs. McCarthy with information on how to best prepare for the PSAT and SAT. You should expect these to come home with your student.
- Please spread the word about our open house (in person) which will be occurring on Thursday April 8 @ 6:30p-7:30p. Staff will be available to answer questions and provide tours to prospective parents. Please support NSH by sharing this event with any parents/families that you feel would benefit from what NSH has to offer.
