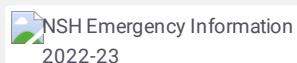
September Parent Advisory

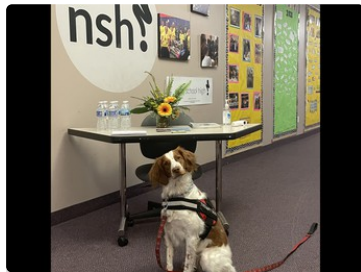
